Outstanding Motions; 9. Name and telephone number of attorney trying the case; 10. Number of witnesses; 11. Number of exhibits; 12. Language issues; 13. If parties or witnesses are out of state.

**CONTINUANCES:**

Pursuant to Rule 8.5 of the Uniform State Court Rules, continuances WILL NOT BE GRANTED MERELY BY AGREEMENT OF COUNSEL OR BY TELEPHONE. This Court requires that all requests for continuance must be submitted, in pleading form, and must be received by the Court at least five (5) days prior to the call of the calendar. If mailed, send to address listed below. Requests shall contain the following information: Reason for requesting the continuance; length of time to be continued (i.e. 30, 60, 90 days); if opposing counsel or party agrees to continuance; if continuances have previously been granted, to which party and for what reason; an Order for Judge Bratton's signature in the event the request is granted. It is the responsibility of the requesting party to ascertain if continuance has been granted and to notify all parties. Note: Continued cases will lose calendar position.

**APPEARANCE OF COUNSEL:**

Pursuant to Rule 8.4 of the Uniform State Court Rules, parties and counsel are subject to being called for trial, unless otherwise directed by the Court. Should any of the actions settle or otherwise be removed from the calendar, the next one in sequence shall be moved up. Counsel and/or Pro Se litigants are directed to call 770/822-8640 after 1:00 p.m. on Friday before the week of Jury trials for a list of the cases to appear on the following Monday. Each attorney/party will need to contact 770/822-8640 daily after 4:00 p.m. for an update for the cases which need to appear the following day..

It is required by this Court that any dismissal be submitted to the Clerk of Court and a copy forwarded to Holly Tullis at the e-mail address listed below, prior to case being called for trial. Any settlement announcement shall be submitted to Holly Tullis at the e-mail address listed below, prior to case being called for trial, or the terms of such agreement shall be dictated to the court reporter and made a part of the record. Otherwise, the case may be DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION.
