Plaintiffs shall present evidence in compliance with the applicable rules of evidence and shall be prepared to present a proposed judgment. Failure to appear or to present admissible evidence may result in dismissal of the Complaint for want of prosecution. The Parties may have already received a written Order from this Court, setting their case for a hearing or for trial on Monday, July 1, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. To the extent there is a conflict between the written Order received from the Court and this Notice, the terms of the Order are controlling. Additional cases may be added to this Calendar by separate Order. If the plaintiff files, or anticipates filing, a dispositive motion, then this matter may be removed from the calendar upon request by the plaintiff. Counsel must timely inform the Court of the plaintiff's intent to file a dispositive motion so that the Court may remove the case from the calendar and notify all parties. All such motions shall be filed with the Court no later than June 24, 2019. Failure to file a motion in accordance with this paragraph shall result in a dismissal of the action for want of prosecution. Plaintiff shall serve the defendant with a copy of the motion consistent with the Georgia Civil Practice Act.
