The following calendar is for a **THREE WEEK** period beginning on **JULY 8, 2019**. A consolidated pretrial order, with motions in limine, **MUST BE FILED NO LATER THAN, JUNE 27, 2019**. Failure to submit a pretrial order will result in the case being placed inactive for 90 days. Plaintiff shall be responsible for consolidating the pre-trial order. All other parties shall provide their portions of the pre-trial order to the Plaintiff no later than 2 business days prior to the due date. No party shall submit its own individual portion of the pre-trial order to the court without written certification detailing the party's good-faith efforts to present the court with a fully consolidated order. Cases reset to a jury trial calendar from a peremptory calendar will be subject to dismissal if a consolidated pretrial calendar is not submitted within the time permitted. Counsel of record must notify pro se parties or opposing counsel not listed on the published calendar of the pendency of this trial notice. Attorneys must notify the Staff Attorney three business days prior to court date if a Court Reporter is needed. Counsel will be notified individually when to appear for trial and all cases will be on two 2-hour notice. There will not be a calendar call. Parties and counsel in each case must be ready for trial, as cases will not necessarily be called in the order in which they appear on the calendar.
