There will be a calendar call/pre-trial conference on July 15th, 2019 at 2:00 p.m., attorneys appearing must be the attorneys trying the case or another attorney of record authorized to define the issues and enter into stipulations. Cases may not be called in the order they are published. All cases will remain on two-hour notice. This is a continuing calendar; all cases that are not reached will be carried over to the next calendar and every calendar thereafter until they are reached. If attorneys/parties attended previous calendar calls/pre-trial conferences/peremptory calendars, then you are excused from attending the July 15th, 2019 calendar call/pre-trial conference. APPEARANCE at the calendar call is mandatory. It shall be the responsibility of the Plaintiff's Attorney or Pro Se Plaintiff to contact Booker ; Chip; Washington, Staff Attorney, at booker.washington@fultoncountyg.gov no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 10th, 2019 advising the expected length of trial and the necessary telephone numbers of parties involved. You are required to submit Requests to Charge limit 15 for non-pattern charges via Microsoft Word and a consolidated Pretrial Order to: Booker Washington, Staff Attorney, Suite T2855, 185 Central Avenue, S.W., Atlanta, GA 30303 on or before July 10th, 2019, or the Requests to Charge and CPTO may be emailed to: booker.washington@fultoncountyg.gov. Please send the text of the charge requested and not merely the charge number. Also, please ensure you are using current pattern charge numbers. Please review the calendar and inform the Staff Attorney of any corrections needed to the names of parties and associated counsel that will appear for the call of the calendar. Also note that any corrections to the listed names should also be updated with the Clerk's office. IF PRETRIAL ORDERS AND REQUESTS TO CHARGE HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED, IT WILL NOT BE NECESSARY TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL ONES. HOWEVER IT IS STILL NECESSARY TO REPORT TO BOOKER ; CHIP; WASHINGTON AND APPEAR AT THE CALENDAR CALL. If you are a Plaintiff, a failure to report and appear at the calendar call will result in your case being DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. If you are a Defendant, failure to report and appear at the calendar call will result in the entry of a default judgment. If the Defendant has a counterclaim, failure to report and appear at the calendar call will result in your counterclaim being dismissed for want of prosecution. If your case is called to trial and you are not ready to proceed, your case will be DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. There will be no continuances granted except for statutory grounds. All conflicts and

requests for continuances must be in writing and in this office by June 10th, 2019. Dress appropriately; NO SHORTS, NO HATS, and NO HALTER TOPS AND NO PRINTED T-SHIRTS. PLEASE DO NOT CALL OR EMAIL CHAMBERS TO FIND OUT WHEN YOUR CASE IS GOING OUT. YOU WILL BE GIVEN SUFFICIENT NOTICE BEFORE YOUR CASE IS SET FOR TRIAL. THE COURT WILL NOTIFY PARTIES WHEN A CASE IS CALLED FOR TRIAL. Three week trial calendar beginning on August 5, 2019. Please ensure the attorneys listed below are the attorneys appearing for the calendar call. If not, please contact the Court and Clerk's office to update who will be appearing. Also, please do not contact the Court to determine your position on the trial calendar.
