sel for all parties-or by phone at  
404.613.4512 no later than 4:00  
p.m. on Wednesday February 5,  
2020. A consolidated pretrial

order MUST BE SUBMITTED TO  
THE STAFF ATTORNEY no later  
than Wednesday February 5,  
2020, unless otherwise instruct-  
ed by the Court. If there are any  
motions in limine to be filed, you  
must also submit those along  
with the pretrial order. Attorneys  
must notify the staff attorney  
three business days prior to  
court date if a Court Reporter is  
needed. Attorneys should email  
proposed jury charges no later  
than Friday February 7, 2020.  
Counsel will be notified individ-  
ually when to appear for trial  
and all cases will be on two -2-  
hour notice. There will not be a  
calendar call. Parties and coun-  
sel in each case must be ready  
for trial, as cases will not nec-  
essarily be called in the order in  
which they appear on the calen-  
dar. Previously filed leaves of  
absence will be honored.  
Counsel who have withdrawn or  
represent parties who have been  
dismissed were served with this  
notice because they did not use  
the party management tools to  
remove their names from the File  
and ServeXpress service list.
