Pursuant to USCR 20, the following cases will be called on Tuesday, May 19 2020 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 2-D of the Fulton County Justice Tower, located at 185 Central Avenue, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303. Pursuant to Rule 20 of the Uniform Superior Court Rules, the Clerk of State Court is DIRECTED to publish a list of the following civil actions in which the discovery period has expired, requiring the parties or their attorneys to announce whether the cases appearing thereon are ready for trial and when trial should be scheduled. Failure to appear at the calendar sounding may result in the dismissal without prejudice of plaintiff's action or defendant's answer, counterclaim or cross-claim. If a case is placed on the trial calendar subsequent to the peremptory calendar call, then this notice also serves as the required trial calendar notice pursuant to Uniform Superior Court Rule 8.3. Neither parties nor attorneys are required to appear if the Judge has been advised that the matter remains active AND a full scheduling/case management order announcing when the matter will be ready for trial has been submitted for approval. The proposed case management order should include deadlines for mediation. If the Court has already entered a prior scheduling/case management order, then the Parties are required to appear before submitting a subsequent scheduling/case management order unless the Parties announce the case is ready to be placed upon the next trial calendar. The parties, through counsel, are encouraged to contact the Court through email in advance of the calendar rather than appear. To submit a proposed order disposing of a case, send an email no later than five 5 days before the calendar call to Booker.washington@fultoncountyga.gov To submit a courtesy copy of any pending motions, as required by Uniform Superior Court Rule 6.1, please email a copy of the motion, supporting documents, proposed order and final disposition form, if applicable, to booker.washington@fultoncountyga.gov If any party has a conflict, a conflict letter in FULL COMPLIANCE with Uniform Rules of Superior Court 16 and 17 is required. Requests for continuances will not be granted without legal cause. Continuance from the calendar does not automatically lead to elimination of the requirement to submit a scheduling order. The following cases will be called on May 19, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 2D, Fulton County Justice Center Tower, 185 Central Avenue, Atlanta, Georgia 30303.
