ORDER SCHEDULING CIVIL HEARINGS
July 20th, 21st, 22nd 23rd, 2020

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached list of civil cases be added to the Fayette Civil Hearing Calendar scheduled for July 20th, 2020 in Fayette County Superior Court, Courtroom 2B, Fayetteville, Georgia.

Cases # 1-6 shall report a 9:00a.m. on July 20th, 2020. All other cases will be on a one hour on-call status that day, unless advised otherwise by the Court. Attorneys are to provide the Fayette Clerk and the Judges's office with their e-mails and contact phone numbers to be called when reached on or after July 20th.

IT IS ORDERED that any cases not reach on the week of July 20th will automatically be place on the additional calendar scheduled for the week of August 10th, 2020. The same instruction apply for providing the Court with attorney contact phone numbers and e-mails.

IT IS ORDERED that attorneys are to electronically provide to the Judge's office, the Court Reporter, and opposing counsel all Exhibits, properly marked, and a Witness List. This is to be proved no later than three days before the July 20th hearing date. Any documents/exhibits not presented and marked ahead of any hearing will be deemed inadmissible. Attorneys should be familiar with the Court's electronic document projector (ELMO). There should be no need to exchange documents in Court.

IT IS ORDERED that in the interest of public safety all counsel and parties are always ordered to utilize hand sanitizer and maintain at least six (6) feet of social distance between individuals at all times. Everyone not speaking or testifying is encouraged to wear a face mask or covering. All in person hearings shall be in compliance with public health guidelines.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any parties requesting videoconference hearings must contact the Court by email no later than 48 hours before the scheduled time for the hearing. By contacting Daniel Kilfoyle, Staff Attorney at dkilfoyle@fayettecountyga.gov or Edith Ray, Judicial Assistant at eray@spaldingcounty.com. All e-mails for Counsel and witnesses to take part in the scheduled hearing must be provided to the Court's staff no later than 24 hours before the scheduled hearing. +
