- Counsel for jailed Defendants



At calendar call, each party should be prepared to make known or identify any plea offers, argue any pre-trial motions, provide time estimates, make interpreter requests, and any matters which might impact trial

Any signed-up plea cases will be concluded on June 9, 2021. In person pleas will be taken beginning at 10:00 a.m. Virtual jail pleas will be taken beginning at 1:00 p.m. Any outstanding motions will be heard June 9, 2021. Any plea entered after June 21, 2021 will be a blind plea. Any outstanding motions not heard by June 9, 2021 shall be deemed waived.

This 2-week jury trial calendar begins at 9:00 a.m. on June 21, 2021. Unless instructed otherwise by the Court, every case, *including any civil case ready for jury trial*, is on a 4-hour call. No one should report for trial until notified by the Court.
