There will be a Virtual Zoom Calendar-Call/Pre-Trial Conference on WEDNESDAY, MARCH 2, 2022 at 9:30 am: attorneys appearing must be the attorneys trying the case or another attorney of record authorized to define the issues and enter into stipulations. All parties should be prepared to argue their pre-trial motions and motions in limine virtually on March 2, 2022, at the conclusion of the calendar-call. Voir Dire/ Jury Selection will occur on Tuesday, March 9, 2022, with jurors being virtual on Zoom, and all attorneys, in person, in courtroom 3A at the Fulton County Courthouse. Details about the logistics of the virtual voir dire will be provided to the parties at least three 3 days prior to the beginning of their trial. Cases are listed in NUMERIC order, NOT in their position for trial. All cases will remain on a two-hour notice/ call throughout the remainder of the calendar. This is a continuing calendar; all cases that are not reached will be carried over to the April 5, 2022, calendar and every calendar thereafter until they are reached. All parties are required to submit Requests to Charge limit 15 for non-pattern charges via Microsoft Word and a Consolidated PreTrial Order the Court will not accept PreTrial Orders from each party separately via email no later than 4:00 p.m. on February 28, 2022, 1 to Mrs. Ottrell Edwards [ottrell.edwards@fultoncountyga.gov](mailto:ottrell.edwards@fultoncountyga.gov) the Court's Staff Attorney. Please send the full text of each

of the charges you are requesting and not merely the charge number. Also, please ensure you are using current pattern charges. Please review the calendar and inform Staff Attorney Edwards of any corrections needed to the names of parties and associated counsel that will appear for the call of the calendar. Also, note that any corrections to the listed names should also be updated with the Clerk's office. If there is a Scheduling/ Case Management Order with different dates for submission of materials, the Scheduling/Case Management Order controls. IF PRETRIAL ORDERS AND REQUESTS TO CHARGE HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED, IT WILL NOT BE NECESSARY TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL ONES. If you are a Plaintiff, a failure to report and appear at the calendar call may result in your case being DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. If you are a Defendant, a failure to report and appear at the calendar call may result in the entry of a DEFAULT JUDGMENT. In addition, if Defendant fails to appear, Plaintiff may be allowed to present evidence of damages and a final judgment may be entered as to damages. If the Defendant has a counterclaim, a failure to report and appear at the calendar call may result in your COUNTERCLAIM being DIMSISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. If your case is called to trial and you are not ready to proceed, your case will be DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. There will be no continuances granted except for
