Cases listed below appear on Judge Emily Richardson's Civil Jury Trial Calendar commencing on July 8, 2022, at 9:00 A.M. in Courtroom 5B of the Justice Center Tower, 185 Central Ave, S.W., Atlanta, GA 30303. This will be a split two-week calendar beginning July 8, 2022 for one week and August 9, 2022 for one week. All parties or their attorneys must appear for the calendar call on July 8, 2022, at via Zoom videoconference. At the calendar call, the Court will conduct pre-trial conferences upon request. Failure to appear for the calendar call, if unexcused, may result in dismissal of the case. Cases not called to trial will be placed on a two-hour call. Cases not reached will be continued to the next civil trial calendar. All conflict letters must be submitted one week before the beginning of the trial calendar and follow Uniform Superior Court Rule 17.1 in proposing a resolution. A consolidated pre-trial order and any motions in limine are due by on July 1, 2022. Failure to submit a consolidated pre-trial order conforming to the template of Uniform Superior Court Rule 7.2 will be deemed an election to proceed with a bench trial. Parties are directed to email the staff attorney and provide the estimated length of trial, the chances of settlement, and the results of any mediation of the case by July 1, 2022. The parties are responsible for arranging takedown with a court reporter. Judge Richardson's court reporter, Laura Harris laura.harris@fultoncountyga.gov, may be available, or the parties may supply their own reporter. A takedown fee will apply to transcribe any court proceeding.
