The following cases will be tried during a eight 8 -week period beginning October 31, 2022. THERE WILL BE NO CALENDAR CALL1. Unless notified otherwise, parties and counsel in the first case listed shall appear ready for trial at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, October 31, 2022. All cases will remain on twenty-four hour 24 notice. This is a continuing calendar; all cases that are not reached will be carried over to the next eight week period and every calendar

thereafter until they are reached. It shall be the responsibility of the Plaintiff's Attorney or Pro Se Plaintiff to contact Booker ; Chip; Washington, Staff Attorney, at booker.washington@fultoncountyga.gov no later than 4:00 p.m. on October 27, 2022 advising the expected length of trial and the necessary telephone numbers of parties preferably via email. You are required to submit Requests to Charge limit 15 for non-pattern charges via Microsoft Word and a consolidated Pretrial Order to: Booker Washington, Staff Attorney, via email to booker.washington@fultoncountyga.gov on or before October 27, 2022. Please send the text of the charge requested and not merely the charge number. Also, please ensure you are using current pattern charge numbers. Please review the calendar and inform the Staff Attorney of any corrections needed to the names of parties and associated counsel. Also note that any corrections to the listed names should also be updated with the Clerk's office. **IF PRETRIAL ORDERS AND REQUESTS TO CHARGE HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED, IT WILL NOT BE NECESSARY TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL ONES.** If you are a Plaintiff, a failure to report and appear at the trial may result in your case being **DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION.** If you are a Defendant, failure to report and appear at trial may result in the entry of a default judgment. In addition, if Defendant fails to appear, Plaintiff may be allowed to present evidence of damages and a final judgment may be

entered as to damages. If the Defendant has a counterclaim, failure to report and appear at the trial may result in your counterclaim being dismissed for want of prosecution. If the Parties requested a special setting, your request is under consideration but you were placed on the current calendar in the event the Parties have the flexibility to try the case during the calendar period. In addition, the ORCA backlog project may be able to set your case but it requires that a consolidated pre-trial order is filed before setting dates for the case. If you requested a bench trial in the alternative, that request is also under consideration but your case was placed on this calendar in the event the case can be reached on the jury trial 1 if the Parties requested a pre-trial conference, the Court will hold one before calling your case in for trial. 2 If there is a Scheduling/Case Management Order with different dates for submission of materials, the Scheduling/Case Management Order controls. calendar before the bench trial calendar. In addition, the ORCA backlog project may be able to reach your case as well. There will be no continuances granted except for statutory grounds. All conflicts and requests for continuances must be in writing and in this office by October 27, 2022. Dress appropriately: **NO SHORTS, NO HATS, and NO HALTER TOPS AND NO PRINTED T-SHIRTS.
