Email announcements should include the following. 1 **Case and Position No.**, 2 Plaintiff/Defendant reporting, 3 Estimated length of trial, 4 If Court Reporter is needed, 5 Name and telephone number of attorneys trying the case; 6 **If an interpreter is needed.**

A Consolidated Pre-Trial Order must be filed within five (5) days prior to your case going to trial unless you've filed one previously. Filing a Motion for Summary Judgment or any other type of Motion besides a Motion for Continuance will NOT remove your case from the Jury Calendar.

APPEARANCE OF COUNSEL.

Counsel and/or Pro Se litigants are directed to call **770-822-8518** after 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the jury trial week for a list of the cases to appear on the following Monday Parties in all other actions on the Calendar are expected to be ready for trial and will be subject to a **TWO-HOUR NOTICE**. Counsel and Parties must be able to respond and appear in Court within one (1) hours if called in for trial. There will be a recording for the cases which need to appear the following day **DO NOT APPEAR IF YOUR CASE IS NOT IDENTIFIED IN THE TRIAL RECORDING**

Each attorney and/or Pro Se Defendant will need to contact 770-822-8518 daily after 5:00 p.m. for updates during the trial week(s).

This is a one-week jury trial There will be no calendar call All other cases will be on a TWO-HOUR NOTICE. **Parties and counsel in every case must be ready for trial, as cases will not necessarily be called in the order in which they appear on the calendar.** Proceedings will not be transcribed absent a timely request for a court reporter Continuances are only granted for legal cause The filing of a motion for continuance does not remove or continue a case from the calendar, and cases will not be continued by agreement. If a party has a conflict, a conflict letter in full compliance with Rule 17.1 is **REQUIRED** If an interpreter is needed for a party or a witness, counsel are directed to comply with Uniform Rule 7.3 in making such a request; failure to make a request in a timely fashion, absent good cause, may result in the imposition of costs Original jury charges, plus one (1) copy, must be presented to the Court on the day the case is called for trial Parties will be limited to **ten (10)** requests to charge, excluding any pattern requests, absent good cause shown. The parties should also provide a proposed jury verdict form on the day the case is called in for trial.
